## 1. Introduction

## 2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help the website function properly and provide information to the website owner about how visitors use the site.

Cookies may be:

Session cookies – deleted when you close your browser

Persistent cookies – remain on your device until they expire or are deleted

## 3. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies to:

Ensure the website functions correctly

Improve user experience

Analyse website traffic

Monitor website performance

Support security and fraud prevention

We do not use cookies to sell personal data.

## 4. Types of Cookies We May Use

### 4.1 Essential Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems.

They may include:

Security cookies

Form submission cookies

Cookie consent preferences

## 4.2 Analytics Cookies

We may use analytics tools (such as Google Analytics) to understand how visitors interact with our website.

Analytics cookies may collect:

IP address (anonymised where possible)

Browser type

Pages visited

Time spent on the website

General geographic location

This information helps us improve our website and services.

## 4.3 Functionality Cookies

These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make (such as form entries or preferences) to provide a more personalised experience.

## 5. Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies may be set by third-party services integrated into our website, such as:

Website hosting providers

Embedded content

Analytics providers

We do not control third-party cookies and recommend reviewing their privacy policies where applicable.

## 6. Managing Cookies

You can control and delete cookies through your browser settings.

Most browsers allow you to:

View cookies stored on your device

Delete cookies

Block cookies entirely

Block third-party cookies

Please note that disabling certain cookies may affect website functionality.

## 7. Legal Basis for Processing

Where cookies collect personal data, we rely on:

Consent (for non-essential cookies)

Legitimate interests (for essential functionality)
